Over the past three years, in spite of the economic downturn, our Associate Giving Appeal has established all-time high levels of “giving back” to support Associates in need as well as Mount Carmel patients and their families.

Highlighted are some examples of how we are impacting lives:



Area of Greatest Need

Through generous donations made to the area of greatest need throughout the year Mount Carmel Foundation was able to allocate funds that directly benefit Patient Care providing support for:

- Car seats for uninsured patients
- Glucometer testing strips for uninsured diabetic patients
- Bibles and crucifixes for patient rooms



College of Nursing

Mount Carmel College of Nursing is one of the largest nursing programs in the state of Ohio and has grown more than 80% over the past five years. At a time when the nation faces a critical nursing shortage, scholarships become more essential to prepare the next generation in realizing their nursing dreams. *Through donations made to the Foundation, last year, the Mount Carmel College of Nursing was able to provide scholarships to 153 nursing students totaling \$286,500.*



Community Outreach

Lack of insurance, language barriers and homelessness rank among the major reasons why countless men, women and children in central Ohio are unable to access the health care resources they need. But there is help available. Thanks to the Mount Carmel Community Outreach program more than 4,000 such individuals benefitted from our Outreach services since July 1, 2010. *This service is funded 100% by dollars from the Mount Carmel Foundation.*



Hospice and Palliative Care

Mount Carmel Hospice and Palliative Care helps patients and their families face the emotional, mental and physical challenges that go with serious illness and impending death with calm and reassurance. As part of their comprehensive services they offer Bereavement Services to those that have a lost a loved one. *These grief programs are funded solely by private donations, and there is never a charge for bereavement services.*



Sister Rose Thomas Fund

When a member of the Mount Carmel family encounters a time of hardship or tragedy, the Sister Rose Thomas Fund is here to help. Through this unique fund, associates who are experiencing a financial hardship resulting from unexpected life events are able to get the help they need. *This fund has helped hundreds of Mount Carmel associates over the years.*



Women’s Health Including Mobile Mammography

At Mount Carmel, we offer a full line of healthcare services uniquely designed for women including a Comprehensive Breast Health Program. *Last year, the Foundation was able to raise enough money to purchase a brand new Mobile Mammography Unit, and was able to supplement funding to sustain many of Mount Carmel’s Cancer Survivorship Programs, including Breast Cancer Exercise and Gentle Yoga.*
